

RESOLUTION NO. 4353

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE BID FOR THE BIG BEAR CENTRAL INTERCEPTOR PHASE 2 PROJECT, FROM CANARY CONSTRUCTION INC. OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$525,474.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the TWO (2) sealed bids received on March 24, 2021 have been reviewed by staff, and it is determined that the bid from Canary Construction Inc. of Lewisville, Texas, in the amount of \$525,474.00 is the lowest and most responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, funds for this type of work was allocated as part of the Water/Wastewater Capital Improvement Project Fund budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves the bid for the Big Bear Central Interceptor Phase 2 Project, From Canary Construction Inc. of Lewisville, Texas for the Public Works Department, in the amount of \$525,474.00; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said project shall be paid from the Water/Wastewater Capital Improvement Project Fund in the amount of \$525,474.00 with funding provided from the Water-Wastewater Utility Fund and the Wastewater Impact Fee Fund.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
