A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) REPLACEMENT GENERATOR AND INSTALLATION SERVICES FOR THE MARSHALL BRANCH WEST LIFT STATION FROM WAUKESHA-PEARCE INDUSTRIES, OF HOUSTON, TEXAS, THROUGH THE BUYBOARD COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM; IN THE AMOUNT OF \$118,063.00 FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Keller to purchase one (1) replacement generator and installation services for the Marshall Branch West Lift Station; and

WHEREAS, the Water and Wastewater Utility Fund provides funding for the purchase of said replacement generator and installation services in the amount of \$118,063.00; and

WHEREAS, WHEREAS, the purchase from Waukesha-Pearce Industries, of Houston, Texas, through the BuyBoard Cooperative Purchasing Program has been determined to be the best value and most responsible method of procurement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of one (1) replacement generator and installation services from Waukesha-Pearce Industries, of Houston, Texas, through the BuyBoard Cooperative Purchasing Program in the amount of \$118,063.00, for the Public Works Department and authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost related thereto shall be paid from the Water/Wastewater Capital Improvements Project Fund with funding provided by the Water & Wastewater Utility Fund.
