

ORDINANCE NO. 1882

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT (SUP) FOR AN APPROXIMATELY 2,003 SQUARE FOOT DETACHED POOL HOUSE WITH A VARIANCE TO THE BUILDING HEIGHT, LOCATED ON A 0.85-ACRE LOT ON THE EAST SIDE OF BROADMOOR DRIVE, APPROXIMATELY TWO HUNDRED FEET (200') SOUTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF VANDERBILT DRIVE AND BROADMOOR DRIVE, AT 1717 BROADMOOR DRIVE, BEING LOT 9, BLOCK B, ASHEVILLE ESTATES, AND ZONED SF-36 (SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL - 36,000 SQUARE FOOT MINIMUM), IN THE CITY OF KELLER, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, Blake and Robin Birkenfeld, owner/applicant; have submitted an application to the City of Keller to request a Specific Use Permit (SUP-18-0005), which has been reviewed by the City Staff; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing before the Planning and Zoning Commission was sent to real property owners within three hundred feet (300') of the property herein described at least ten (10) days before such hearing; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing before the City Council was published in a newspaper of general circulation in Keller at least fifteen (15) days before such hearing; and

WHEREAS, public hearings to issue a Specific Use Permit on the property herein described were held before both the Planning and Zoning Commission and the City Council, and the Planning and Zoning Commission has heretofore made a recommendation to approve the Specific Use Permit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the Specific Use Permit herein effectuated furthers the purpose of zoning as set forth in the Unified Development Code and is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, in accordance with the Unified Development Code, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby authorizes approval of a Specific Use Permit (SUP) for an approximately 2,003 square foot detached pool house with a variance to the building height, located on a 0.85-acre lot on the east side of Broadmoor Drive, approximately two hundred feet (200') south of the intersection of Vanderbilt Drive and Broadmoor Drive, at 1717 Broadmoor Drive, being Lot 9, Block B, Asheville Estates, and zoned SF-36 (Single Family Residential - 36,000 square foot minimum), in the City of Keller, Tarrant County, Texas, with the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein, as if fully set forth with the following conditions:

1. The Specific Use Permit request for the 2,003 square-foot accessory building exceeding fifty percent (50%) of the main structure is to be considered.
2. The variance request to allow the average building height to exceed fifteen feet (15') to be considered.

Section 3: THAT, any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, as read together with the Unified Development Code and accompanying map thereto, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon final conviction therefore shall be fined in a sum not to exceed Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00). Each and every day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

Section 4: THAT, the City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to cause publication of the descriptive caption and penalty clause hereof as an alternative method of publication provided by law.

AND IT IS SO ORDAINED.
