## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, FOR PROVIDING STAFF AND RESOURCES TO PERFORM WORK FOR TARRANT COUNTY ON COVID RELATED ACTIVITIES; FOR A TERM OF TWENTY-FOUR (24) WEEKS COMMENCING JANUARY 12, 2021 AND TERMINATING ON JUNE 30, 2021; TO INCLUDE PERFORMING DUTIES AS ASSIGNED AT A DESIGNATED VACCINATION SITE; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

- WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Keller to participate in the North East Tarrant County Vaccination site/clinic; and
- WHEREAS, city staff will be available to perform work for Tarrant County on COVID related activities; and
- WHEREAS, the term of this agreement will be twenty-four weeks commencing January 12, 2021 and terminating June 30, 2021; and
- WHEREAS, this Agreement shall be in conformance with, and is authorized by, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, more commonly known as the "Interlocal Cooperation Act".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
- Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves an Interlocal Agreement with Tarrant County, Texas, for participating in the North East Tarrant County Vaccination Site; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.
- Section 3: THAT, Keller and Tarrant County desire to enter into said Agreement to provide a COVID Vaccination site in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
