

RESOLUTION NO. 4065

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH TEAGUE NALL AND PERKINS, OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ENGINEERING SERVICES, RELATING TO THE RECONSTRUCTION OF JOHNSON ROAD FROM HALLELUJAH TRAIL TO RHONDA ROAD, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$714,100.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Staff has reviewed the qualifications of Teague Nall and Perkins, of Fort Worth, Texas, and this firm is well qualified to provide the conceptual design services for said project; and

WHEREAS, the City Staff recommends Teague Nall and Perkins, of Fort Worth, Texas be used to perform the necessary surveys, right of way acquisition, design, bidding, construction management, and construction inspection services for said project, in a total amount of \$714,100.00; in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement for Professional Services, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves an Agreement for Professional Services with Teague Nall and Perkins, of Fort Worth, Texas be used to perform the necessary surveys, right of way acquisition, design, bidding, construction management, and construction inspection services for said project, in a total amount of \$714,100.00; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said Agreement for Professional Services be funded from the Street System Capital Improvement Program fund with funding from the General

Fund, Street and Sidewalk Maintenance Fund, and Roadway Impact Fee Funds. A future budget amendment will be required to consolidate the various project budgets and transfer other funding sources to the Johnson Road project.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
