A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A PAYMENT TO TDINDUSTRIES, INC. OF DALLAS, TEXAS, THROUGH THE TEXAS ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL BOARDS (TASB) BUYBOARD COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, FOR THE EMERGENCY REPLACEMENT OF A SEWER LINE AND GREASE TRAP INTERCEPTOR FOR FIRE STATION #2, FOR THE FACILITIES DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$103,230.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to maintain a properly functioning sanitary sewer and grease trap interceptor for Fire Station #2; and

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2025, city staff issued a PO for the emergency replacement to the sanitary sewer and grease trap interceptor for Fire Station # 2; and

WHEREAS, City staff selected TDIndustries, Inc., of Dallas, Texas, through the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) BuyBoard Purchasing Cooperative, to provide said emergency repairs in the amount of \$103,230.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves a payment to TDIndustries, Inc. of Dallas, Texas through the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) BuyBoard Purchasing Cooperative, for the emergency replacement to the sanitary sewer and grease trap interceptor for Fire Station # 2; and

Section 3: THAT, the cost of the said project shall be paid from the Facility Replacement Fund, with funding provided by the General Fund, in the amount of \$103,230.00.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
