A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL EMERGENCY PRE-EMPTION EQUIPMENT FROM PARADIGM TRAFFIC SYSTEMS, OF ARLINGTON, TEXAS, THROUGH THE BUYBOARD PURCHASING COOPERATIVE, FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$117,900.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to purchase Traffic Signal Emergency Pre-Emption Equipment for the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the current vehicle-mounted emergency pre-emption equipment utilized by the Keller Fire Department is outdated and requires replacement in order to maintain compatibility with the City's upgraded traffic signal management system; and

WHEREAS, the replacement equipment will allow fire apparatus to communicate with the City's traffic signal infrastructure in order to safely and efficiently navigate signalized intersections during emergency response operations; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends the purchase of Traffic Signal Emergency Pre-Emption Equipment from Paradigm Traffic Systems, of Arlington, Texas, through the BuyBoard Purchasing Cooperative, in the amount of \$117,900.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of Traffic Signal Emergency Pre-Emption Equipment from Paradigm Traffic Systems, of Arlington, Texas, through the BuyBoard Purchasing Cooperative, in the amount of \$117,900.00, and authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of the purchase shall be paid from the Fleet Replacement Fund with funding provided by the General Fund.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
