

RESOLUTION NO. 4968

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF SCHOOL ZONE COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT FROM PARADIGM TRAFFIC SYSTEMS, OF ARLINGTON, TEXAS, THROUGH THE BUYBOARD PURCHASING COOPERATIVE, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$83,700.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to purchase School Zone Communications Equipment for the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the current school zone timer devices are obsolete and do not contain communications capability, limiting their ability to integrate with the City's traffic management system; and

WHEREAS, this project will replace the existing timers with upgraded devices that include communication capability, allowing them to be managed and monitored through the City's traffic management system; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends the purchase of School Zone Communications Equipment from Paradigm Traffic Systems, through the Buyboard Purchasing Cooperative, in the amount of \$83,700.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of School Zone Communication Equipment from Paradigm Traffic Systems of Arlington, Texas, through the BuyBoard Purchasing Cooperative, in the amount of \$83,700.00, and authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of the purchase shall be paid from the Street Maintenance division of the Public Works departmental operating budget with funding provided by the General Fund.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
