RESOLUTION NO. 4398

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF THE NICE DIGITAL RECORDING SYSTEM UPGRADE, TO INCLUDE A NEW AUDIO LOGGING RECORDING SERVER, INFORM 9 PROFESSIONAL SOFTWARE, AND SIX SCREEN RECORDING LICENSES, FROM MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$144,978; FOR THE REGIONAL NETCOM DISPATCH & DETENTION CENTERS AS WELL AS THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION AND ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the current NETCOM NICE Recording System has reached the end of its useful life and is no longer compatible with other systems utilized by the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Staff recommends the purchase of the NICE Digital Recording System upgrade to best serve the needs of the community and Keller's regional partners; and

WHEREAS, funds for said upgrade are available through the Crime Control and Prevention District FY 2020-21 savings and FY 2021-22 allocated budget in the total amount of \$144,978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves the purchase of the NICE Digital Recording System Upgrade, in the total amount of \$144,978, according to the terms and conditions set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto; for the Regional NETCOM Dispatch & Detention centers as well as the Criminal Investigation and Administrative Division of the Police Department, and authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said system shall be paid from the Crime Control and Prevention District.
