To the Keller City Council,

We are writing to notify you of our opposition to the SUP for McClure Partners' request for a liquor store between our subdivision and Keller Parkway. We oppose a liquor store with such close proximity to a subdivision with home values over \$500,000.00, as it may discourage our ability to sell our home to all sellers. We are also concerned for an increase in late night traffic, potentially with drivers under the influence of alcohol. Similarly, this has potential to negatively affect the youth of our city with Keller High School and two other schools within Keller ISD less than two miles away from the proposed location. Finally, the presence of a liquor store in the backyard of our subdivision creates a less affluent environment than many homeowners are looking for. We pay heavy HOA dues, and the covenants require homeowners to keep our homes and yards in proper condition; to have a liquor store adjacent to our property will cheapen our neighborhood.
