Justification for Requested Variance:
The proposed development will require the removal of existing trees. As per the Tree Survey and Preservation Plan, 179 tree caliper inches will require mitigation. The landscape plan
shows all required site trees have been provided. 74 caliper inches of mitigation has been
provided by planting trees not required by ordinance and by un-sizing the caliner sizes of

provided by planting trees not required by ordinance and by up-sizing the caliper sizes of

several trees. 105 caliper inches remain, and cannot be mitigated by planting additional trees on the site. Planting additional trees on-site would require that trees be planted too close together, and too close to paving and building walls. We therefore request that we be allowed to mitigate the 74 caliper inches on the plan as shown, and mitigate the remaining 105 caliper inches by making a payment into the Tree Fund. The Ordinance states that the payment shall

be not less than \$100.00 per caliper inch.

A detailed letter of justification and/or exhibits shall accompany this application.

Protected Tree: A tree that is listed in Section 8.19 of the UDC and has a diameter of three inches (3") or greater measured at four feet six-inches (4' 6") above ground for large trees and two inches (2") or greater measured at four feet six-inches (4' 6") above ground for understory trees.
