## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR COMBINED MUNICIPAL COURT SERVICES FOR THE CITIES OF COLLEYVILLE AND KELLER; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the cities of Colleyville and Keller entered into an Interlocal Agreement for Combined Municipal Court Services dated April 4, 2013 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement's initial term expired on September 30, 2018, and the cities of Colleyville and Keller extended the term of the Agreement for an additional five (5) year renewal term (the "First Renewal Term"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement's first renewal term expired on September 30, 2023, and the cities of Colleyville and Keller desire to extend the term of the Agreement for an additional five (5) year renewal term (the "Second Renewal Term") in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, upon full review and consideration of the Agreement, the Second Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement for Combined Municipal Court Services for the Cities of Colleyville and Keller which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A", and all matters related thereto, the City Council for the City of Keller has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to approve the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT the City of Keller hereby approves the Second Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement for Combined Municipal Court Services for the Cities of Colleyville and Keller, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A"; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all necessary documents to effectuate the same.

Section 2: THAT, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
