

RESOLUTION NO. 4479

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH SYDAPTIC INC., FOR THE PURCHASE, PROGRAMMING, AND INSTALLATION OF BUILDING SECURITY AND ACCESS CONTROL EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE FOR THE DETENTION CENTER, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$192,325; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to upgrade the Detention Center's Access Control System; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2021-22 Keller Crime Control and Prevention District Annual Budget provided for the purchase of said Security and Access Control services; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of said building security and access control upgrades from Sydaptic Inc., is included in an inter-local agreement with The Colony, Texas, who entered into an agreement with Sydaptic, Inc., with a similar statement of work to upgrade their jail access control system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the agreement with Sydaptic Inc., for the purchase, programming, and installation of building security and access control equipment and software for the Detention Center, in the amount of \$192,325, and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said purchase of building security and access control upgrades for the Detention Center, shall be paid from the Keller Crime Control and Prevention Fund, budgeted therefor.
