A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A BAUER VERTECON SE 18 SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS (SCBA) AIR COMPRESSOR SYSTEM, INCLUDING RELATED EQUIPMENT, SHIPPING, INSTALLATION, TRAINING, AND AN ANNUAL SERVICE AND AIR TESTING AGREEMENT, FROM AUGUST INDUSTRIES, LLC, THROUGH THE BUYBOARD COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$70,639.45; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE PURCHASE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Keller Fire Department utilizes a Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) air compressor system to refill breathing air cylinders used by firefighters during emergency response operations; and

WHEREAS, the existing SCBA air compressor system has reached the end of its useful service life and requires replacement to ensure the continued safety, reliability, and operational readiness of the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, August Industries, LLC, has submitted a proposal through the BuyBoard Cooperative Purchasing Program (Contract No. 798-26) for the purchase and installation of a Bauer Vertecon SE 18 SCBA air compressor system, including related equipment, shipping, installation, training, and an annual service and air testing agreement, in an amount not to exceed \$70,639.45;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the purchase of the SCBA air compressor system is necessary to support the continued delivery of essential fire protection and emergency response services to the citizens of Keller.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the findings set forth above are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2: THAT, the purchase and installation of a Bauer Vertecon SE 18 Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) air compressor system, including related equipment, shipping, installation, training, and an annual service and air testing agreement, from August Industries, LLC, through the BuyBoard Cooperative Purchasing Program, in an amount not to exceed Seventy Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars and Forty-Five Cents (\$70,639.45), is hereby approved.

Section 3: THAT, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all agreements, purchase orders, and other documents necessary to complete the purchase and installation of the equipment on behalf of the City.

Section 4: THAT, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
