

RESOLUTION NO. 4367

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) REPLACEMENT LADDER TRUCK, FROM METRO FIRE APPARATUS SPECIALISTS, INC., OF SOUTH HOUSTON, TEXAS, THROUGH THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON AREA COUNCIL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM; FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to replace vehicles in a timely manner to avoid increased repair costs and service delivery delays; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2021-22 Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund will fund \$1,484,644 for one (1) replacement ladder truck; and

WHEREAS, the proposed fire apparatus will help maintain the city's Insurance Services Office (ISO) rating of 2, which can impact residents and other property owners' insurance rates; and

WHEREAS, the procurement of the ladder truck in the amount of \$1,484,644 through the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) Cooperative Purchasing Program has been determined to be the lowest and most responsible method of purchasing therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of one (1) replacement ladder truck as presented in Exhibit "A" through the HGAC Cooperative Purchasing Program for \$1,484,644; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of the ladder truck purchase shall be funded from the Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund.
