A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT SEWER EASEMENT MACHINE AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT, FROM CLS EQUIPMENT COMPANY, INC. OF RICHARDSON, TEXAS, THROUGH THE BUYBOARD PURCHASING COOPERATIVE, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$71,066.88, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to purchase a replacement sewer easement machine and associated equipment, for the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2022-23 Fleet Replacement Fund budget provides for the purchase of said sewer easement machine and associated equipment in the amount of \$71,066.88; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of said sewer easement machine and associated equipment through the contract with the Buyboard Purchasing Cooperative has been determined to be the lowest and most responsible method of purchasing therefore.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of a sewer easement machine and associated equipment from CLS Equipment Company, Inc. of Richardson, Texas, through the Buyboard Purchasing Cooperative, in the amount of \$71,066.88; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said sewer easement machine and associated equipment shall be paid from the Fleet Replacement Fund, in the amount of \$71,066.88, with funding provided by the Water & Wastewater Utility Fund, budgeted therefor.
