

RESOLUTION NO. 5058

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, ORDERING A RUNOFF ELECTION TO FILL THE OFFICE OF CITY COUNCIL PLACE 4 (UNEXPIRED TERM) FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, TO BE HELD ON JUNE 13, 2026, AS SET FORTH BY THE CHARTER AND THE TEXAS ELECTION CODE.

WHEREAS, a Special Election was duly held in the City of Keller, Texas, on the 2nd day of May 2026 to fill the office of City Council Place 4 as set forth by the Charter and the Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has met and canvassed the votes cast and declared that no candidate received a majority of the votes cast in said election for City Council Place 4.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: **Election Ordered.**

(a) A Runoff Election shall be held in the City of Keller, Texas on June 13, 2026, to elect a person to fill the unexpired term for the office of City Council Place 4, to serve until May 2028, or until a successor is duly elected and qualified.

(b) Said election shall be conducted by the Tarrant County Elections Administrator pursuant to a Joint Election Agreement and Contract for Election Services approved by the City Council.

Section 3: **Runoff Election Candidates.** Candidates to be running in the Runoff Election on June 13, 2026, are as follows:

Section 4: **Election Officers.** The election officers for each polling place shall be appointed and compensated pursuant to the Joint Election Agreement and Contract for Election Services with the Tarrant County Elections Administrator, for said runoff election on June 13, 2026.

Section 5:

a. Early voting by personal appearance. Early voting shall be conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code. The Tarrant County Elections Administrator/Early Voting Clerk shall determine the early voting locations, dates, and hours and is authorized to make changes as necessary for the proper conduct of the election. Early voting locations shall include, but are not limited to:

- Tarrant County Elections Center, 2700 Premier Street, Fort Worth, TX 76111
- Keller Town Hall, 1100 Bear Creek Parkway, Keller, TX 76248

Additional early voting locations may be designated by the Elections Administrator pursuant to joint election agreements.

b. Early voting by mail. The Tarrant County Elections Administrator, 2700 Premier Street, Fort Worth, Texas 76111, is hereby appointed as Early Voting Clerk.

Applications for a Ballot by Mail must be received by the Early Voting Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, June 2, 2026, and may be submitted by mail, fax, or email to:

c. Early voting ballot board. The Early Voting Ballot Board shall be appointed in accordance with the Joint Election Agreement and the Texas Election Code.

Section 6:

Election Day Polling Places and Election Hours. On Election Day, June 13, 2026, polling places shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at locations designated by the Tarrant County Elections Administrator. All City of Keller registered voters may vote at any designated polling location. Final polling locations will be published prior to Election Day.

Section 7: **Method of Voting.** The Tarrant County voting equipment shall be used, and the election shall be conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code.

Section 8: **Governing Law.** The election shall be held pursuant to the City Charter and the Texas Election Code, and all qualified registered voters of the City of Keller shall be eligible to vote.

Section 9: **Effective Date.** This resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
