RESOLUTION NO. 4658

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPOINTING THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AS THE PRIMARY DESIGNATED OFFICER AND APPOINTING THE ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES MANAGER AS THE SECONDARY DESIGNATED OFFICER RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CALCULATION OF THE NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE, VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE, AND PERFORMING ALL OTHER DUTIES NECESSARY FOR THE SUBMISSION OF THE TAX RATE TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 26 OF THE TEXAS TAX CODE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 26, Section 26.04 Subsection (C) of the Texas Tax Code states that an officer or employee of a taxing entity shall calculate the No-New Revenue tax rate and Voter-Approval tax rate for the unit; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 26, Section 26.04 Subsection (C) of the Texas Tax Code states that the officer or employee for the unit be designated by the governing body of the taxing entity; and

WHEREAS, the positions deemed to possess the appropriate knowledge and background to complete the calculation of the No-New-Revenue tax rate and the Voter-Approval tax rate is deemed to be the Director of Administrative Services as the primary and the Administrative Services Manager as the secondary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, The City Council hereby designates the position of Director of Administrative Services as the primary and Administrative Services Manager as the secondary, as the officer or employee of the City of Keller designated to calculate the No-New-Revenue tax rate, the Voter-Approval tax rate, and to perform all other duties and obligations necessary to effect submission of the tax rate to the City Council as required by Chapter 26 of the Texas Tax Code.

Section 3: THAT, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
