

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH WILSON BAUHAUS INTERIORS, OF DALLAS, TEXAS, FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF FURNITURE FOR THE KELLER POLICE DEPARTMENT, THROUGH THE OMNIA COOPERATIVE PURCHASING FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT PROGRAM, THE INTERLOCAL PURCHASING SYSTEM, AND THE NATIONAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING ALLIANCE, IN A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$343,284.33; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to purchase and install furniture in the Keller Police Department; and

WHEREAS, funding for the furniture for the Keller Police Department is budgeted in the Crime Control and Prevention District (CCPD) Budget; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of said furniture from Wilson Bauhaus Interiors, of Dallas, Texas, through the OMNIA Cooperative Purchasing for Local Government Procurement Program, The Interlocal Purchasing System, and the National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance, has been determined to be the best value and most responsible method of purchasing therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the agreement with Wilson Bauhaus Interiors, of Dallas, TX, for the purchase and installation of furniture in the Keller Police Department, in the amount of \$343,284.33, through the OMNIA Cooperative Purchasing for Local Government Procurement Program, The Interlocal Purchasing System, and the National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance, for the Keller Police Department; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said purchase of furniture for the Keller Police Department, shall be paid from the Facilities Capital Improvement Project Fund with funding provided from the Crime Control and Prevention District (CCPD) Budget, budgeted therefor.
