A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF IRRIGATION PARTS AND COMPONENTS FROM LONGHORN, INC., OF DALLAS, TEXAS, FOR A CENTRAL CONTROL SYSTEM, THROUGH THE INTERLOCAL PURCHASING SYSTEM (TIPS) PURCHASING COOPERATIVE PROGRAM, FOR THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$57,231.23; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to update the irrigation systems at the Keller Sports Park and Keller Town Hall; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2025-26 adopted Keller Development Corporation Budget includes funding for the central control system; and

WHEREAS, the purchase from Longhorn, Inc., of Dallas, Texas through The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) Purchasing Cooperative has been determined to be the lowest and most responsible method of purchasing therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves the purchase of irrigation parks and components from Longhorn, Inc., of Dallas, Texas through The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) Purchasing Cooperative in the total amount of \$57,231.23; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said purchase of these irrigation parts and components shall be paid from the FY 2025-26 Keller Development Corporation Budget in the amount of \$57,231.23 budgeted therefor.
