

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT (SUP) FOR MASTERS OF BARBERING, A SPA PROPOSED IN AN EXISTING 1,711 SQUARE-FOOT LEASE SPACE ON APPROXIMATELY 1.4 ACRES, LOCATED AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF N. MAIN STREET AND KELLER HICKS ROAD, LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS LOT 1, BLOCK 1 OF THE TOMMY TACKETT ADDITION, ZONED OLD TOWN KELLER AND ADDRESSED 413 N. MAIN STREET, IN THE CITY OF KELLER, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, Cody Perez, Applicant, and Budribrohers Real Estate LLC, Owner, submitted a Specific Use Permit (SUP) application to operate a spa use at 413 North Main Street. (SUP-2409-0007); and

WHEREAS, an SUP is required to operate a spa in the Old Town Keller (OTK) zoning district; and

WHEREAS, the City's Planning and Zoning Commission and the City Council, in accordance with the Charter of the City of Keller, State Law, and the ordinances of the City of Keller, have given the required notices and have held the required public hearings regarding the SUP application described in this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the SUP herein effectuated furthers the purpose of zoning as set forth in the Unified Development Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, in accordance with the Unified Development Code, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby authorizes approval of a Specific Use Permit (SUP) for Masters of Barbering to operate a spa in an existing 1,711 square-foot lease space on approximately 1.4 acres, located at the northwest corner of the intersection of N. Main Street and Keller Hicks Road, legally described as Lot 1, Block 1 of the Tommy Tackett Addition, zoned Old Town Keller and addressed 413 N. Main Street.

Section 3: THAT, any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, as read together with the Unified Development Code and

accompanying map thereto, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon final conviction therefore shall be fined in a sum not to exceed Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00). Each and every day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

Section 4: THAT, the City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to cause publication of the descriptive caption and penalty clause hereof as an alternative method of publication provided by law.
