A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH TEAGUE, NALL AND PERKINS OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS FOR THE BEAR CREEK PARKWAY BRIDGE EROSION PROTECTION PROJECT, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$228,150.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Keller to add erosion protection to the Bear Creek Parkway bridge; and

WHEREAS, city staff recommends a professional engineering firm be used to perform the necessary engineering services relating to the Bear Creek Parkway Bridge Erosion Protection Project; and

WHEREAS, the firm of Teague, Nall and Perkins of Fort Worth, Texas is hereby recommended to provide said engineering services in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement for Professional Services, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves an agreement with Teague, Nall and Perkins of Fort Worth, Texas to provide engineering services relating to the Bear Creek Parkway Bridge Erosion Protection Project, in the amount of \$228,150.00, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in said Agreement for Professional Services; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said project shall be paid from the Street System Capital Improvements Project Fund, with funding provided by the General Fund in the amount of \$228,150.00, budgeted therefor.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
