

RESOLUTION NO. 4151

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH SCIENS CONSULTING TO PROVIDE CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE CAD, RMS, JMS, AND MOBILE SOFTWARE REPLACEMENT PROJECT FOR THE REGIONAL PARTNERSHIP CONSISTING OF KELLER, SOUTHLAKE, COLLEYVILLE, WESTLAKE, AND GRAPEVINE; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Keller to replace the CAD/RMS/JMS, and Mobile Software for the Regional Partnership consisting of Keller, Southlake, Colleyville, Westlake, and Grapevine; and

WHEREAS, the City Staff recommends approving Sciens Consulting to provide consulting services for the CAD, RMS, JMS, and Mobile Software Replacement Project for the Regional Partnership; and

WHEREAS, the regional partnership unanimously agreed to utilize Sciens Consulting to provide the following services relating to the Regional CAD/RMS project: Assessment and Planning, Request for Proposal Development, Vendor Evaluation and Selection, and Contract Negotiation.

WHEREAS, Sciens Consulting will provide consulting services at a total cost of \$108,380, which will be shared between the City of Keller, City of Southlake, City of Colleyville, and City of Grapevine.

WHEREAS, Regional Partnership cities will be each be responsible for contributing \$27,095.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves an agreement for consulting services, with Sciens Consulting, to provide for the CAD, RMS, JMS, and Mobile Software Replacement

Project, for the Regional Partnership consisting of Keller, Southlake, Colleyville, Westlake, and Grapevine, in an amount of \$27,095; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said Agreement for Consulting Services shall be paid from the Keller Crime Control and Prevention District sales tax.

AND IT IS SO RESOLVED.
