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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH KIMLEY-HORN OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS; FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING BIDDING AND CONSTRUCTION PHASE SERVICES RELATING TO THE BATES STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$518,700.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2020, City Council approved Resolution 4250 authorizing a Professional Services Agreement with Kimley-Horn to provide engineering design services for the Bates Street Reconstruction project; and

WHEREAS, the engineering consultants with Kimley-Horn that designed the project have a high degree of familiarity with the project and are thus best suited to oversee the bidding and construction phases; and

WHEREAS, the scope and complexity of the Bates Street Reconstruction project will require additional inspection, oversight, documentation and coordination; and

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions set forth in the new agreement for bidding and construction phase services are attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves an Agreement for Professional Services with Kimley-Horn for the bidding and construction phase services, relating to the Bates Street Reconstruction project, in the amount of \$518,700.00; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
