A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE FY 27 APPROPRIATIONS REQUESTS TO THE OFFICE OF UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE BETH BAN DUYNE RELATED TO REQUESTS FOR THE BEAR CREEK WATER LINE REPLACEMENT, MELODY DRAINAGE AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS, AND VARIOUS INTERSECTION SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed providing exceptional water, transportation, and drainage infrastructure as a core function of a local government; and

WHEREAS, the dedication to these core functions are what helps make Keller “Texas’s Most Family-Friendly City”; and

WHEREAS, the proposed FY 27 appropriation requests of \$30 million for water line replacement with Southlake addresses, of \$12 million for Melody Lane drainage and pedestrian improvements, and of \$12 million for various intersection safety improvements address core functions of a local government; and

WHEREAS, the City of Keller and City of Southlake will provide match funding of \$7,500,000 each for a total of \$15,000,000 in match funds for the water line replacement project, and the City of Keller will provide match funding of \$3 million for the Melody Lane drainage and pedestrian improvements project and of \$3 million for the various intersection safety improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller supports the FY 27 appropriation requests.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves and supports the FY 27 appropriation requests to the Office of United States Representative Beth Van Duyne’s related to the Bear Creek water line replacement with Southlake, Melody Lane drainage and pedestrian improvements, and various intersection safety improvements.
