RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION ESTIMATE FOR THE BEAR CREEK PARKWAY SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD OF OMAHA, NEBRASKA, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$61,948.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Keller, Texas to design and construct the Bear Creek Parkway Sidewalk Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, city staff has reviewed and evaluated the construction estimate from Union Pacific Railroad and determined it to be reasonable; and

WHEREAS, funds for this work are budgeted in the Street System Capital Improvements Project Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves the construction estimate for the Bear Creek Parkway Sidewalk Improvements Project, from Union Pacific Railroad of Omaha, Nebraska, for the Public Works Department, in the amount of \$61,948.00; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said project shall be paid from the Street System Capital Improvements Project Fund, with funding provided by the General Fund in the amount of \$61,948.00, budgeted therefor.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
