City of Keller

- WHEREAS* emergencies can occur at any time that require police, fire or emergency medical services; and,
- WHEREAS* when an emergency occurs the prompt response of police officers, firefighters and paramedics is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and,
- WHEREAS* the safety of our police officers, firefighters and paramedics is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who telephone the North East Tarrant Communication Center; and,
- WHEREAS* Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and,
- WHEREAS* Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our police officers, firefighters and paramedics by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information and ensuring their safety; and,
- WHEREAS* Public Safety Telecommunicators of North East Tarrant Communication Center have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and,
- WHEREAS* each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Armin R. Mizani, Mayor of the City of Keller, Texas, and on behalf of our City Council and citizens, do hereby proclaim the week of April 9 through 15, 2023, as
