C. MINUTES

Mrs. Hensley updated the Board on the progress regarding all upcoming Public Art events for 2020. She shared the potential for Ballet Frontier of Texas to perform "The Nutcracker" in December at the Keller High School.

1. Budget Update

Mrs. Hensley shared that the current fund balance for the Public Arts Special Revenue Fund remains \$171,856. There are pending expenditures of \$15,000 to Brad Oldham Sculptures, and sculpture pad construction, TBD.

2. Receive an update on the Animal Services Sculpture project

Mrs. Hensley shared that she has requested the architect of the sculpture plaza make changes to the original design to be more cost effective. When the revised plans are received, the project will then be sent out to bid again.
