A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR THE FUNDING OF THREE FULL-TIME SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS AND ONE LESS THAN FULL-TIME SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER FOR THE KELLER POLICE DEPARTMENT, BETWEEN KELLER INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the Keller Independent School District, and the City of Keller, Texas desire to be subject to the provisions of the Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, the Interlocal Cooperation Act; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas that the security and well-being of students within the Keller schools is paramount, and that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Keller to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Keller Independent School District, Texas for the funding of three full-time School Resource Officers and one less than full-time School Resource Officer, for the Keller Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Keller Independent School District shall assist in the funding of School Resource Officers with the Keller Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves an Interlocal Agreement for the funding of two full-time School Resource Officers and one less than full-time School Resource Officer, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", for the Keller Police Department, between Keller Independent School District and City of Keller, Texas.
