 - Documented/accountable each day, each school (patrol, traffic, supervisors, etc)
 - Field reporting visibility
 - Volunteers in Police Services (VIPS)

 - St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School
 - Messiah Lutheran Classical Academy

Additional

- Training:
 - Keller and Ft. Worth PD partnering with KISD Safety & Security training each KISD campus 8/29 10/21
 - Both staff and students
 - Tailored for grade levels
- KISD Director of Safety & Security & KPD Police Chief to visit each campus
 - Meet with Principals
 - Ensure consistency in direction and unified voice
- Drill Dates established at beginning of school year
- Monthly meeting between SRO's and KISD Director of Safety & Security
 - Identify trends throughout district
