

RESOLUTION NO. 4490

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) REPLACEMENT EMERGENCY GENERATOR AND INSTALLATION SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$237,756.00 FROM FORT WORTH ELECTRIC OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS THROUGH THE CONTRACT AND INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH TARRANT REGIONAL WATER DISTRICT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to purchase one (1) replacement emergency generator and installation services, for the City of Keller; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Facility Capital Replacement Fund budget provides for the purchase of said emergency generator and installation services in the amount of \$237,756.00; and

WHEREAS, the purchase from Fort Worth Electric, Inc. of Fort Worth, Texas through the contract and interlocal agreement with Tarrant Regional Water District has been determined to be the lowest and most responsible method of purchasing therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of one (1) replacement emergency generator and installation services from Fort Worth Electric of Fort Worth, Texas through the contract and interlocal agreement with Tarrant Regional Water District in the amount of \$237,756.00; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said purchase of one (1) replacement emergency generator and installation services, shall be paid from the Facility Capital Replacement Fund, in the amount of \$237,756.00 with funds provided from the American Rescue Plan Act funds and the Facility Capital Replacement Fund.

AND IT IS SO RESOLVED.
