Replacement Funding

3 Methods to fund replacement

- Cash fund at time of replacement
- Debt fund at time of replacement
- Prepay / Set aside for replacement

Cash Fund

- Keller Crime Control and Prevention District (KCCPD) Police & Animal Services
 Equipment
- Keller Development Corporation Park Maintenance Equipment (mowers, tractors, etc.)
- Heavy Equipment (Currently)

Replacement Funds

- Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund (VERF)
 - Light & Medium Duty Vehicles
 - Fire Apparatus (Engines, Ambulances)
 - Fire/EMS Equipment
 - Recently replaced Heavy Equipment
- IT Replacement Fund
 - Computers
 - Servers
- Facility Replacement Fund
 - Air Conditioners
 - Roofs
 - Carpet

FY 2021-22 Replacement Summary

- Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund (VERF)
 - Light/Medium Duty Vehicles = 7
 - Heavy Equipment = 3
 - Fire Engine= 1
 - Total replacement funding = \$1,818,029
 - Total one-time cash funding = \$137,000
- Fire/EMS Equipment Replacement = \$54,800
- KCCPD Fund
 - 6 Replacements
 - 1 SWAT Vehicle
 - Total cash funding = \$502,700
- Facility Replacement = \$1,034,470
