A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A \$75,075.00 PROPOSAL FROM ANDERSON ASPHALT AND CONCRETE OF DALLAS, TEXAS; TO STABILIZE SHADY GROVE FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AS PART OF THEIR PERFORMANCE BOND OBLIGATION; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Anderson Asphalt and Concrete of Dallas, Texas was the original contractor providing rehabilitation services on Shady Grove Rd; and

WHEREAS, Anderson Asphalt and Concrete of Dallas, Texas is required to replace failed pavement surface as part of their 2-year performance bond commitment on Shady Grove Rd; and

WHEREAS, Anderson Asphalt and Concrete of Dallas, Texas is able to perform base stabilization improvements for \$75,075.00 to Shady Grove Rd as part of their performance bond work; and

WHEREAS, City staff confirms this additional base stabilization is required to avoid similar future base failures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves a contract with Anderson Asphalt and Concrete of Dallas, Texas; to stabilize Shady Grove for the Public Works Department as part of their performance bond obligation; at a cost not to exceed \$75,075.00; and authorizing the City Manager to execute all documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said work shall be paid from the Fiscal Year 2026 Street Improvement Fund budget in the amount of \$75,075.00.

Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
