A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE BID FROM YOKO EXCAVATING, LLC., OF BELTON, TEXAS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$272,693.00 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE BARBARA LANE HIKE AND BIKE TRAIL CONNECTION, FOR THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to construct a hike and bike trail connection from Barbara Lane to the Big Bear Creek Greenbelt Trail; and

WHEREAS, the engineering firm of Westwood was used to develop a design issued for competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, an RFP for Construction Services was advertised in accordance with State Law, and sixteen bids were received on January 24, 2023, and Yoko Excavating, LLC., of Belton, Texas, was the lowest bidder at \$272,693.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves the bid from Yoko Excavating, LLC., in the total amount of \$272,693.00; and authorizes the City Manager to execute all documents relating thereto, on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said contract with Yoko Excavating, LLC., shall be paid in the amount of \$272,693.00 by the Parks Capital Improvement Project Fund. Funds for the project were provided by the Keller Development Corporation Fund.
