A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE CITY OF KELLER'S COST PARTICIPATION IN THE REPLACEMENT OF COMPONENTS 1 AND 2 OF THE MOTOROLA UPGRADE TO THE NETCO MOTOROLA P25 TRUNKED RADIO COMMUNICATION SYSTEM; AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO THE CITY OF BEDFORD FOR KELLER'S SHARE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Keller participates in the North East Tarrant County (NETCO) Radio Consortium, an interoperable public safety radio network consisting of the cities of Keller, Colleyville, Southlake, Grapevine, Bedford, and Euless; and

WHEREAS, the member cities are parties to an interlocal agreement to build, own, operate, and maintain a regional nine-channel trunked radio system, with the City of Bedford serving as the original purchaser and contract administrator; and

WHEREAS, the NETCO Technical Committee has recommended the replacement of components 1 and 2 of the Motorola P25 Trunked Radio Communication System to maintain compliance, enhance reliability, and ensure integration with modern technologies; and

WHEREAS, the cost of Keller's participation in the replacement of components 1 and 2 is \$137,363.84, and sufficient funds are available and appropriated in the FY 2024-25 Crime Control and Prevention District (CCPD) budget in the amount of \$161,218; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bedford will facilitate the payment to Motorola on behalf of all member cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the City Council hereby authorizes the payment of \$137,363.84 to the City of Bedford as the City of Keller's cost share for the replacement of components 1 and 2 of the Motorola P25 Trunked Radio Communication System in accordance with the NETCO interlocal agreement.

Section 2: THAT, the City Manager is authorized to take all actions necessary to facilitate this transaction in accordance with the NETCO interlocal agreement.

Section 3: THAT, this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
