## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE 1.5 MG WHITLEY ELEVATED STORAGE TANK PROJECT, WITH N.G. PAINTING, LLC OF KERRVILLE, TEXAS, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, AND AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to rehabilitate the 1.5 MG Whitley Elevated Storage Tank for the City of Keller; and

WHEREAS, the three (3) sealed bids received on October 31, 2024 have been reviewed by staff, and it is determined that the bid from N.G. Painting, LLC of Kerrville, Texas in the amount of \$1,976,960.00, is the most responsible bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the construction contract for the Rehabilitation of the 1.5 MG Whitley Elevated Storage Tank Project with N.G. Painting, LLC of Kerrville, Texas, for the Public Works Department, in the amount of \$1,976,960.00; and further authorizes the Interim City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said project shall be paid from the Water & Wastewater Capital Improvements Project Fund, with funding provided by the Water & Wastewater Utility and ARPA funds, in the amount of \$1,976,960.00 budgeted therefor.
