## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE KELLER SERVICE CENTER SANITARY SEWER RELOCATION PROJECT, FOR RNO CONSTRUCTION, LLC, OF DALLAS, TEXAS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$587,170.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

- WHEREAS, the City of Keller has an ongoing sanitary sewer replacement program to replace existing sanitary sewer lines; and
- WHEREAS, the construction of said project will help reduce the City's risk for sanitary sewer overflows, in accordance with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's sanitary sewer overflow elimination initiative; and
- WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bid was received from RNO Construction, LLC of Dallas, Texas in the amount of \$587,170.00. City staff, with the aid of a consulting engineer has reviewed qualifications and recommends that RNO Construction, LLC of Dallas, Texas is qualified to perform the work required to complete the project.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:
- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.
- Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves the a construction contract for the Keller Service Center Sanitary Sewer Relocation Project from RNO Construction, LLC of Dallas, Texas, for the Public Works Department, in the amount of \$587,170.00 and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.
- Section 3: THAT, funding for this project is contained in the Water & Wastewater Capital Improvements Project Fund with funding provided by the Water & Wastewater Utility Fund budgeted therefore.
- Section 4: THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
