A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH BRINKLEY SARGENT WIGINTON ARCHITECTS, INC. OF DALLAS, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTATION OF THE KELLER POLICE DEPARTMENT AND CITY HALL RENOVATION PROJECT; IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$611,500.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

- WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to renovate the Keller Police Department and City Hall; and
- WHEREAS, the City Staff recommends a professional design consulting firm to be used to perform the necessary services, relating to the Keller Police Department and City Hall renovations project; and
- WHEREAS, the firm of Brinkley Sargent Wiginton Architects, Inc. of Dallas, Texas is hereby recommended to provide said professional services, in the amount of \$611,500.00, for the Police Department and City Hall Renovation Project; in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement for Professional Services, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

- Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety
- Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves a contract agreement for professional services with Brinkley Sargent Wiginton Architects, Inc. of Dallas, Texas, for the purpose of providing the design and construction documentation of the Keller Police Department and City Hall renovation project, in an amount not to exceed \$611,500.00; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.
- Section 3: THAT, the cost of said Agreement for Professional Services shall be paid from the Facility Capital Replacement Fund for City Hall renovations and Crime Control & Prevention District (CCPD) Fund for the Police Department renovations.
