AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A SPECIFIC USE PERMIT (SUP) FOR COUNTY LINE RECORDS, TO OPERATE A RETAIL STORE WITH USED GOODS AND MERCHANDISE SALES, LOCATED IN AN APPROXIMATELY 2,500 SQUARE-FOOT LEASE SPACE, ON APPROXIMATELY .86 ACRES LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH MAIN STREET AND JOHNSON ROAD, LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS LOT 1R1, BLOCK 1 OF THE L.L. MCDONNELL ADDITION, ZONED COMMERCIAL (C) AND ADDRESSED TO 600 NORTH MAIN STREET, BUILDING 2, IN THE CITY OF KELLER, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, Mark Keel, Owner, Lorissa Holder, Applicant, submitted a request for a Specific Use Permit (SUP-2501-0001) for the sale of used goods and merchandise in the Commercial Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the City's Planning and Zoning Commission and the City Council, in accordance with the Charter of the City of Keller, State Law, and the ordinances of the City of Keller, have given the required notices and have held the required public hearings regarding the SUP application described in this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion the SUP request herein effectuated furthers the purpose of zoning as set forth in the Unified Development Code and is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, in accordance with the Unified Development Code, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby authorizes approval of a Specific Use Permit (SUP) for County Line Records, to operate a retail store with used goods and merchandise sales, located in an approximately 2,500 square-foot lease space, on approximately .86 acres located at the intersection of North Main Street and Johnson Road, legally described as Lot 1R1, Block 1 of the L.L. McDonnell Addition, zoned Commercial (C) and addressed to 600 North Main Street, Building 2.

Section 3: THAT, any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon final conviction therefor, shall be fined in a sum not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00). Each and every day any such violation continues
