**B. MINUTES CONSENT**

1. **Minutes Consent-** Michelle Hur moved to approve the minutes of the Keller Library Board meeting from February 2, 2026 as written. Elizabeth Gauwain seconded the motion. It was passed.

1. **Friends of the Library Report-** February's meeting featured Bob Stephenson presenting Slam Poetry. Mr. Stephenson has competed in Slam both nationally as well as internationally. Next meeting scheduled March 19<sup>th</sup>.
2. **Keller Reads: One Book, One City 2026-** Featuring *Code Girls* by Liza Mundy. Events are beginning this week. The ticketed banquet event currently has 59 tickets sold, with a goal of 75.
3. **Staffing Changes-** Lost a Part-time Cataloger, however promoted from within. Also lost Cullen Dansby, who took a job with the Fort Worth Public Library in a promoted position. Ann Flourney is currently interviewing for a replacement Circulation & Public Services Manager.
4. **Guided Topics Collection Project Update-** Ann Flourney informed that the project will be completed by the end of the week.
5. **Meeting Room Mural Project Update-** Project partnership with Hudson Foundation and Keller Public Arts Board. Anya Bosworth, a local Keller artist, was selected. A concept meeting has been completed. She is scheduled to begin work on April 5<sup>th</sup> with an estimated 40 hours to complete.
6. **January 2026 Library Usage Statistics-** Mahjong Monday continues to be a very popular program with 70 participants in January (the highest attended January program). KPL is seeing an increase in the notary services with the addition of 2 more staff notaries. The Sensory Room continues to decline in usage. KPL Staff are currently brainstorming ways to increase usage of the room.
