## **RESOLUTION NO. 4670**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH LOCKWOOD, ANDREWS & NEWNAM (LAN), OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS; FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ENGINEERING DESIGN, RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY REPAIR FOR THE HIGHLAND OAKS CROSSING CHANNEL GABION REPAIR PROJECT, FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$90,420.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Keller maintains drainage channels throughout the city; and

WHEREAS, a section of the Highland Oaks Crossing Channel needs repair; and

WHEREAS, the City Staff has reviewed the qualifications of Lockwood, Andrews and Newnam of Fort Worth, Texas, and this firm is well qualified to

provide design services for said project; and

WHEREAS, the City Staff recommends Lockwood, Andrews and Newnam of Fort

Worth, Texas to perform the engineering design for said project, for a total amount of \$90,420.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and

are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas hereby approves an

Agreement for Professional Services with Lockwood, Andrews and Newnam of Fort Worth, Texas; for the purpose of providing engineering design services, relating to the emergency repair of the Highland Oaks Crossing Channel Gabion Repair project, for the Public Works Department, in the amount of \$90,420.00; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all contract documents relating thereto on

behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said project shall be paid from the Drainage

Maintenance operations budget, with funding provided by the Drainage

Utility Fund, in the amount of \$90,420.00, budgeted therefor.

Section 4: THAT, a budget amendment may be required for the emergency

engineering and repairs.

Section 5:	THAT, this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
