City of Keller Planning and Zoning:

When Goody Goody applied for its original specific use permit (SUP), it submitted artist's renditions of the building, including signage. All of the signage submitted on this original application were the architect's drawings and were not official logos of Goody Goody nor was it Goody Goody's intent to ever place that specific signage on the store.

The signage originally submitted over the entrance to the store did not have the verbiage "Wine Beer Liquor" underneath the name. Additionally, the name was not a true representation of the Goody Goody logo.

Goody Goody wishes to submit an SUP amendment application to replace the signage that was submitted in the approved SUP with signage that represents the official Goody Goody logo and states what they sell.

Goody Goody feels it is important for their sign to state what goods or services they provide especially with a name like Goody Goody. Without the verbiage of "Wine Beer Liquor" on the sign, someone under the age of 21 may try to enter the store thinking they sold candy or food. It is also important for a business' sign to be visible and read easily from the main thoroughfare to allow drivers that are seeking out the business to read the sign at a glance thus limiting the amount of time their eyes are off the road.

You will find approved drawings A3.01, A3.02, and A3.03 are attached which show the original elevations and signage submitted. The proposed signage that Goody Goody would like to place on the building is described in the last two pages of the document.
