- 5. New Local History Collection and Policies- Jessica Vondra- Part-Time Circulation Clerk & is pursuing her Library Science Degree from UNT gave a presentation on the new Keller History Collection. The collection will be unveiled on May 17h during a Keller Through the Ages History Lecture.
