

Consider an ordinance calling a Special Election to be held on November 3, 2025, in the City of Keller, Texas, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters a proposed amendment to the City Charter, Section 4.01 - Elections, in accordance with the Texas Local Government Code and Texas Election Code.

Option I: Full Transition to November Elections (2026)

- All elections move to November starting in 2026
- November 2026: Mayor, Place 5, and Place 6
- November 2027: Place 1 and Place 2
- November 2028: Place 3 and Place 4
- Annual November elections continue with staggered 3-year terms
- No election held in May 2026

Option II: Begin Transition in 2027, Keep the May 2026 Election

- May 2026 election proceeds for Mayor, Place 5, and Place 6 (terms end Nov. 2029)
- November 2027: Place 1 and Place 2
- November 2028: Place 3 and Place 4
- Annual November elections begin in 2027 with staggered 3-year terms

Option III: Transition to 2-Years-On, 1-Year-Off Cycle

- May 2026 election held for Mayor, Place 5, and Place 6 (terms end Nov. 2029)
- November 2027: Places 1-4 elected (terms end Nov. 2030)
- Election cycle:
 - 2029: Mayor, 5, 6
 - 2030: Place 1, 2, 3, 4
 - 2031: No election
- Cycle repeats with staggered 3-year terms
