

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE CITY OF KELLER TITLE VI NON-DISCRIMINATION PLAN; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND PERIODIC REVIEW OF THE PLAN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in programs and activities receiving federal financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, federal and state laws and regulations further prohibit discrimination on the basis of age, sex, and disability in applicable programs, services, and activities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Keller is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under any City program, service, or activity; and

WHEREAS, the City has developed a Title VI Non-Discrimination Plan to establish policies, procedures, and practices that promote compliance with applicable nondiscrimination requirements; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Title VI Non-Discrimination Plan supports the City's ongoing commitment to equal access, public participation, and compliance with applicable federal and state requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the City Council hereby adopts the City of Keller Title VI Non-Discrimination Plan, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Exhibit A.

Section 2: THAT, the City Manager, or designee, is authorized and directed to implement and administer the Title VI Non-Discrimination Plan and to make such administrative updates as may be necessary to maintain compliance with applicable laws, regulations, and guidance.

Section 3: THAT, the Title VI Non-Discrimination Plan shall be reviewed and updated periodically, but no less than once every three (3) years, or as otherwise required by law or applicable regulatory guidance.

Section 4: THAT, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
