RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF ENTERPRISE ASSET MANAGEMENT PUBLIC WORKS SOFTWARE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,624,348, FROM TYLER TECHNOLOGIES; AND AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to purchase new public works software, for the City of Keller; and

WHEREAS, the staff issued a Request for Proposal for software in February 2024 and determined Enterprise Asset Management from Tyler Technologies to be the best value and best meets the city's public works software needs; and

WHEREAS, the total purchase price is \$1,624,348 and includes implementation and tenyears of recurring services and support; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2024-25 Information Technology Fund included funding for the implementation and first year of support of \$900,000, with carry-over costs to be addressed during the annual budget process; and

WHEREAS, Future support costs will be included in future budget years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of Enterprise Asset Management public works software from Tyler Technologies; as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto; and further authorizes the Interim City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said purchase of software, shall be funded from Information Technology Fund with funding from the General Fund and Water and Wastewater Utility Fund, in the amount of \$1,624,348, budgeted therefor.
