**B. MINUTES CONSENT**

3. **February & March 2026 Library Usage Statistics-** Big event was Library Olympics- Late Night at the Library. Nothing surprising with the stats for either month.
4. **PLA & TXLA Conference Reports-** Josh Cade, Adult Services Librarian, & Rachel Fettenberger, Library Services Manager, both attended the Public Library Association Biannual Conference in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Rae Washington, Teen Services Librarian, attended the Texas Library Association Annual Conference in Houston, Texas.
5. **Maker Station Project Updates-** KPL is holding a Showcase of the new machines on April 8<sup>th</sup> with demonstrations and hands on patron learning. The Maker Station will be available to any library card holder 13+, patrons under the age 13 will need an adult. The Board was given a tour of the closet and machines that will be offered.
6. **FY2026 Q2 Patron & Program Feedback Survey Reports-** Several of the Patron feedback items have already been addressed. The Program Feedback was overwhelmingly positive.
