A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING FY2025-26 PURCHASE OF A BACKHOE FROM ASSOCIATED SUPPLY COMPANY, INC. OF EULESS, TEXAS, THROUGH THE BUYBOARD COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM; IN THE AMOUNT OF \$172,810.50; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to replace vehicles and equipment in a timely manner to avoid increased repair costs and service delivery delays; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund will provide \$172,810.50 for a replacement backhoe; and

WHEREAS, the purchase from Associated Supply Company, Inc. of Lubbock, Texas through the Buyboard Purchasing Cooperative has been determined to be the lowest and most responsible method of purchasing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of a replacement backhoe from Associated Supply Company, Inc. of Lubbock, Texas through the Buyboard Purchasing Cooperative in the amount of \$172,810.50; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost to purchase said backhoe, and related equipment, shall be paid from the 2025-26 Fleet and Equipment Replacement Fund budget with funding provided by the Water & Wastewater Utility Fund, in the amount of \$172,810.50 budgeted therefor.
