EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

ABV Training LLC / dba Sit Means Sit Fort Worth franchise (SMS) was established in 2008 and assumed by the current owner, Stephanie Putnam in 2017. SMS offers dog training through a researched and proven method under the care of trainers on staff. The training is customized to each animal and it's owner. Our aim is to produce good behavior around multiple distractions, while maintaining the dog's focus on the handler.

COMPANY DESCRIPTION

Mission Statement: Revolutionizing the quality of life with happy, obedient, and confident dogs.

With this mission in-mind, we customize our training approach to meet with our customer's personality as well as what will result in the best possible training experience for both dog and owner. As you view our portfolio of dog training videos, we hope that you will pay close attention to the attitude of all the dogs trained by Sit Means Sit. We pride ourselves on being able to maintain a happy and relaxed attitude in our dogs. Simply stated, we want our clients to have more fun with their dog as a result of our system.

PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

Day Training

Maintaining stability in a learning dog's life is very important. With the day training option, the trainers spend the day with the dog working on obedience and behavioral issues. At the end of the session, the owner is instructed on how to continue the training at home.

Private Lessons

Private lessons offer a more hands-on approach with the dog's training. One of the experienced trainers will meet with the owner and their dog once a week to teach techniques and strategies that can be implemented on their own time at home.

Group Classes

Once the above recommended training is completed, there is the opportunity for group classes. Group class is the perfect setting for the dog to practice their new skills in the midst of their greatest distraction: other dogs.

MARKET ANALYSIS

SMS currently operates as a mobile dog trainer meeting in community parks, such as Bear Creek Park in Keller. The area veterinarian offices recognize the quality dog training offered and are referral partners.

Currently in Keller, there are no other dog training store front facilities in operation. SMS will be unique in that it offers a day training program or private lessons along with group classes in this new facility.

STRATEGY AND IMPLEMENTATION

SMS has also enlisted a Marketing Strategist, who specializes in dog training businesses, to ensure that the marketing and advertising dollars allocated are directed correctly to produce quality leads. We will be implementing a marketing budget of ten percent of our gross sales toward this targeted demographic surrounding the facility in order to attract potential clients. When these potential clients receive an evaluation of their dog in the facility our historical rate of signed contracts is seventy percent of our total leads. Training begins shortly thereafter.

FINANCIAL PLANS AND PROJECTIONS

Building and Renovations

SMS executed a 7 year lease for the 2090 square feet suite at 363 Keller Parkway, Keller, Texas. The storefront faces the most traveled roadway running east to west from Southlake to I-35W.

In conjunction with the lease, the landlord will reimburse leasehold improvements up to \$41,800. The expected cost of improvements is \$48,000.

Financial Projections

The mobile training model will remain unchanged and continue to support the operational costs of the new facility until it is able to generate revenues to support its standalone costs.

Upon the completion of the building improvements, SMS will open for day training upon receipt of the Certificate of Occupancy from the City of Keller. The monthly fixed costs for operations in the new facility are as follows:
