

RESOLUTION NO. ____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF FLOCK SAFETY AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER (ALPR) SOFTWARE, AND SUPPORT EQUIPMENT, IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$386,850 OVER A 5 YEAR PERIOD. YEAR 1 IS \$98,850 AND THE FOLLOWING YEAR 2-5 ARE \$72,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Keller to purchase Flock Safety Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) system along with the associated supporting infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 City of Keller Crime Control and Prevention District Budget provided for the purchase of said Flock Safety Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) system along with the associated supporting infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the purchase from Flock Group has been determined to be the lowest and most responsible method of purchasing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KELLER, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Keller, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of Flock Safety Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) system along with the associated supporting infrastructure from Flock Group, Inc. for \$386,850 over a 5 year period. Year 1 is \$98,850 and the following year 2-5 are \$72,000; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Keller, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the costs of the purchase be made from the Keller Crime Control and Prevention District Budget.
